

I found you a new home, it's this garbage, get in and pull the garbage over your head please




This is unacceptable--what? Unacceptatory? Is that even a word? I don't get it. What are you trying to say here, Lemongrab??

Wait, Peebs, I thought you said before that Lemongrab was the first of your experiments gone wrong!




Lemongrab was the first of my experiments gone wrong **THAT DAY**. There were like, three more that same evening. I also burnt my breakfast the next morning. Rough times!

I shouldn't have said "experiment gone wrong". You're an experiment gone... out to explore the world on his own terms, and I'm happy you're happy.


