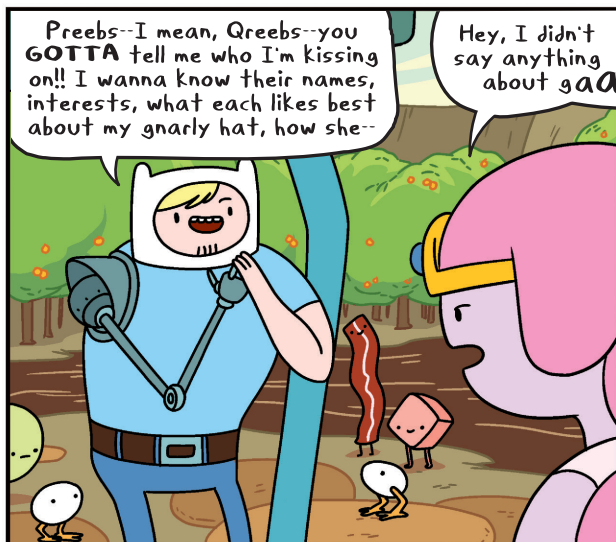
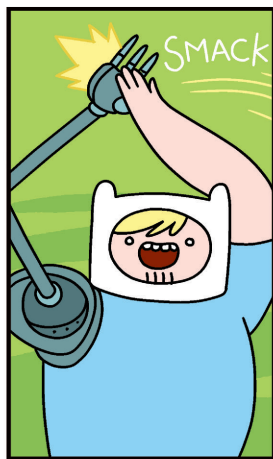
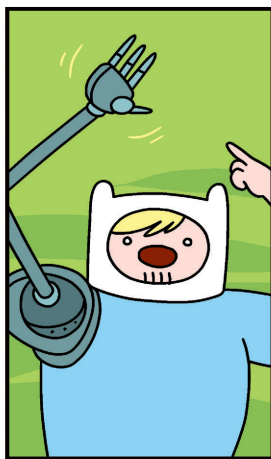
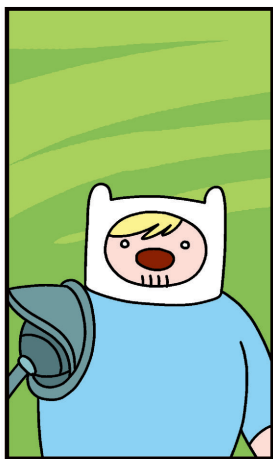


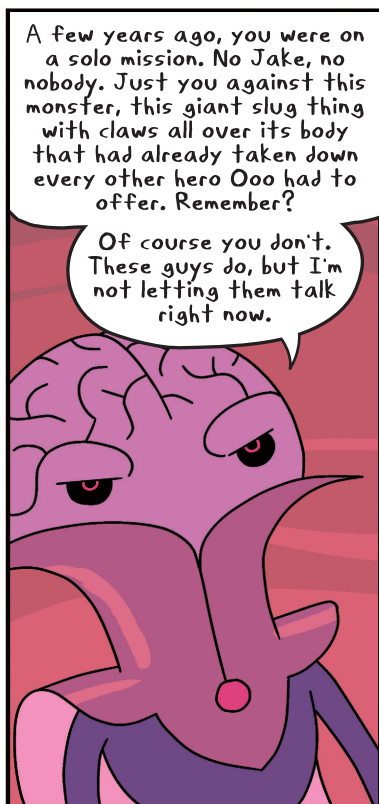












And this monster there, his breath wet on your face, his tentacles mere inches from your head; he pauses. He pauses for just a second and says "Why not?"

"And killing an idea never works," you say.

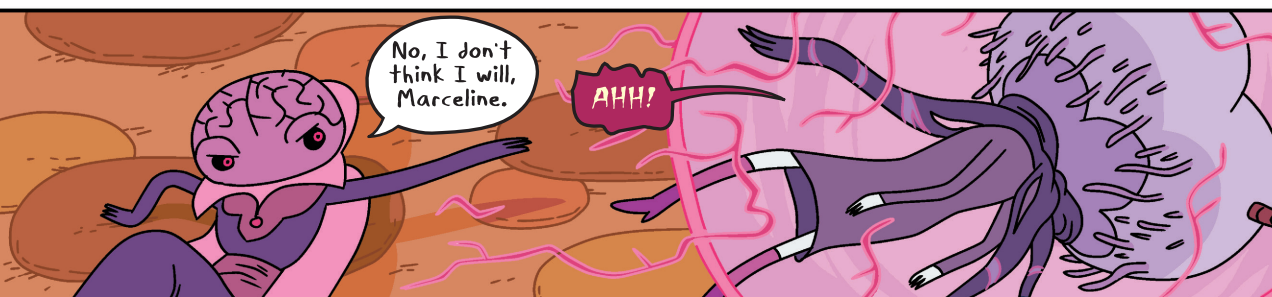
