


I've said it before, so I'm being consistent, LSP isn't a princess, and I've always thought she shouldn't be in this competition. So I think LSP should go.

















For this, your final challenge, you must locate the ultimate prize, the Princess Heart, a jewel both magical and rare.

A jewel that represents the heart of what makes a princess great, the prize of her people.





