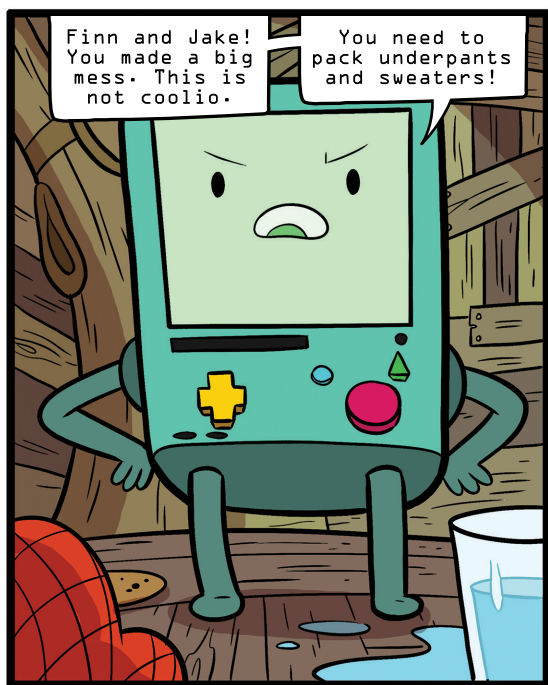


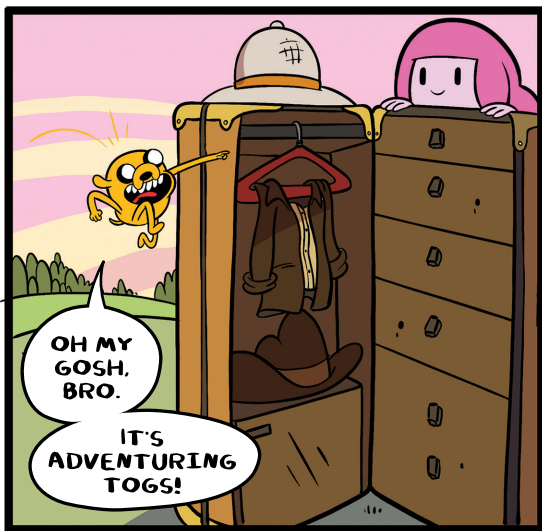
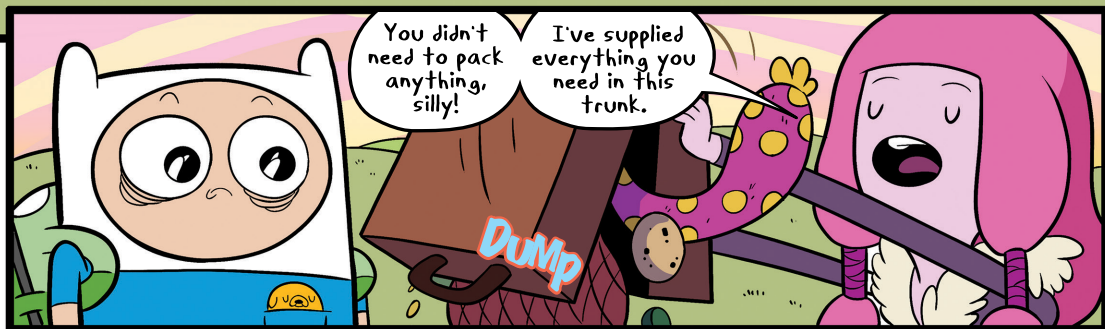
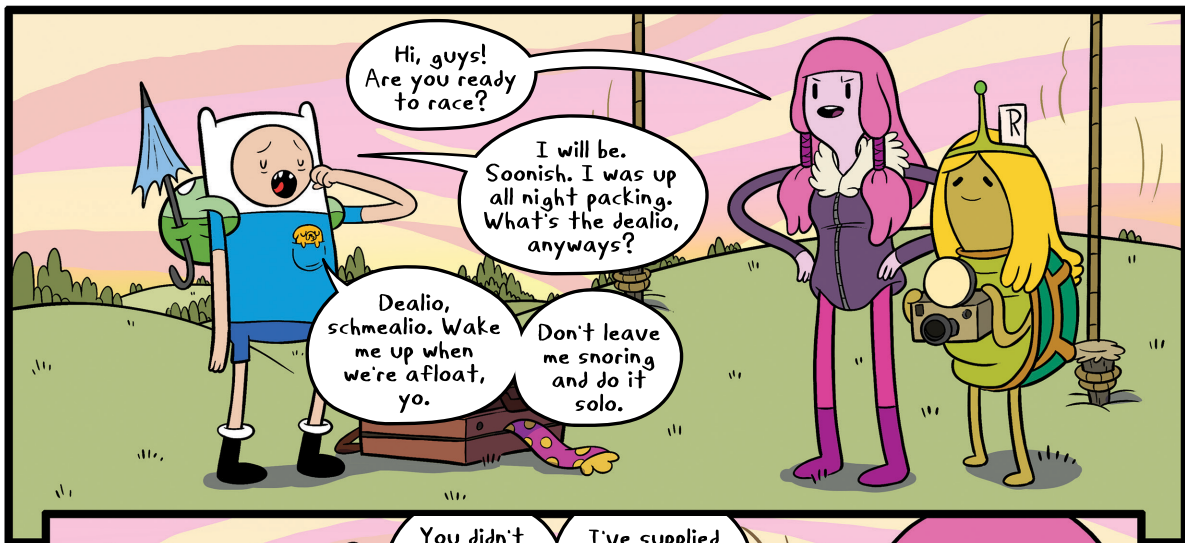






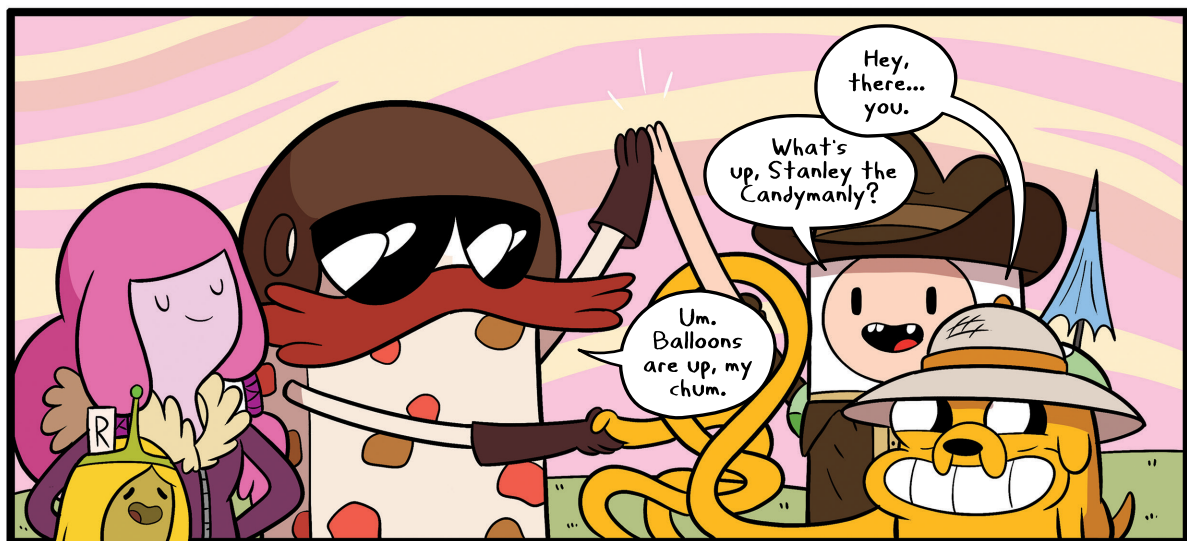
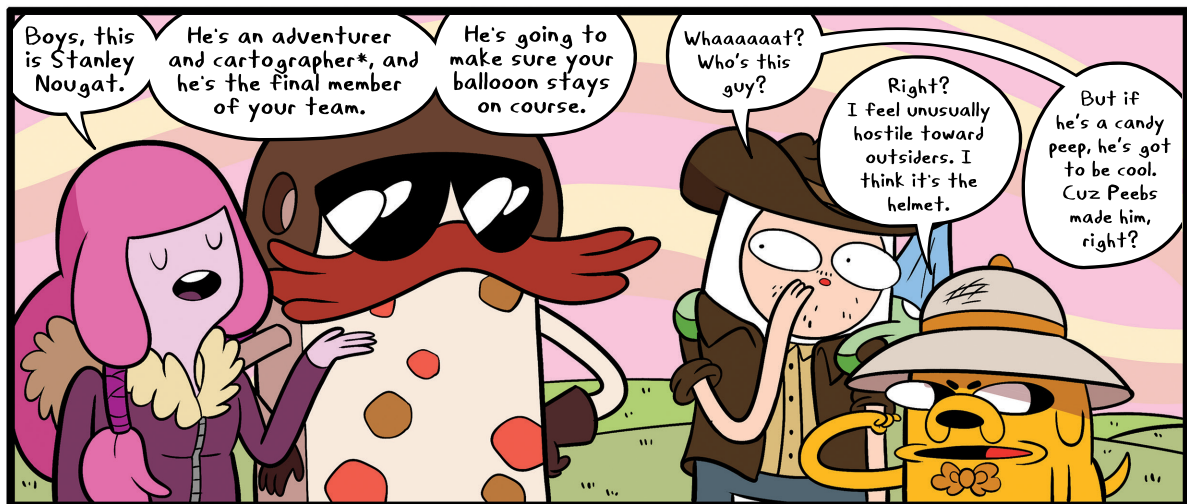
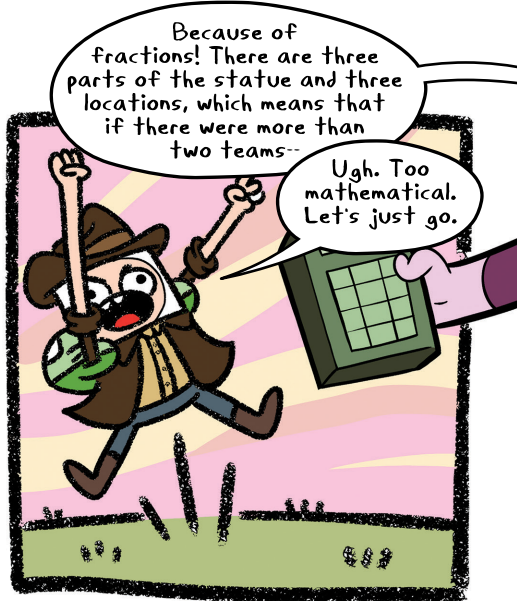






1. Two teams will race to find the TREASURE!

5. Your entire team has to make it back...ALIVE!

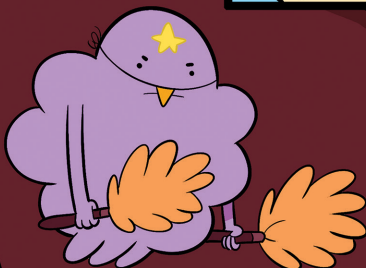
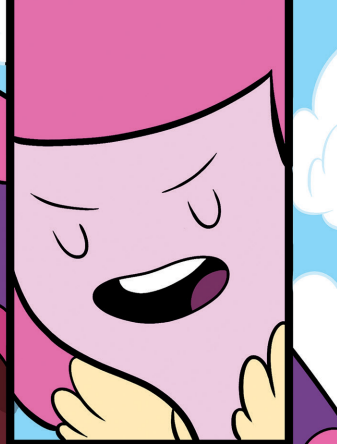

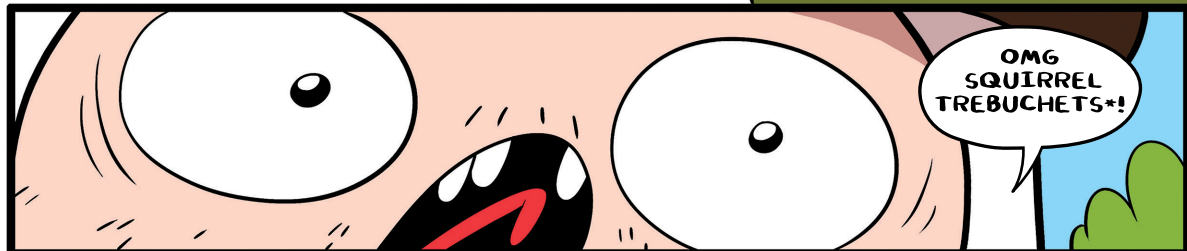
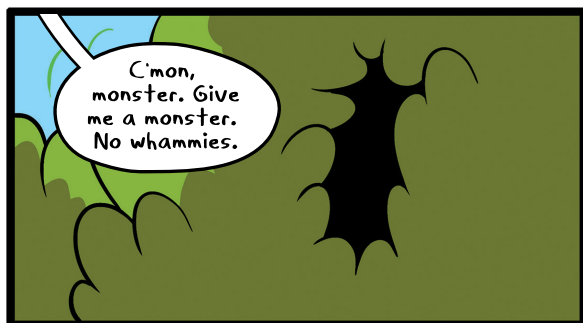
*Sextant (noun): A navigation instrument that measures the angle between two visible objects. So, like, a thing for maps.



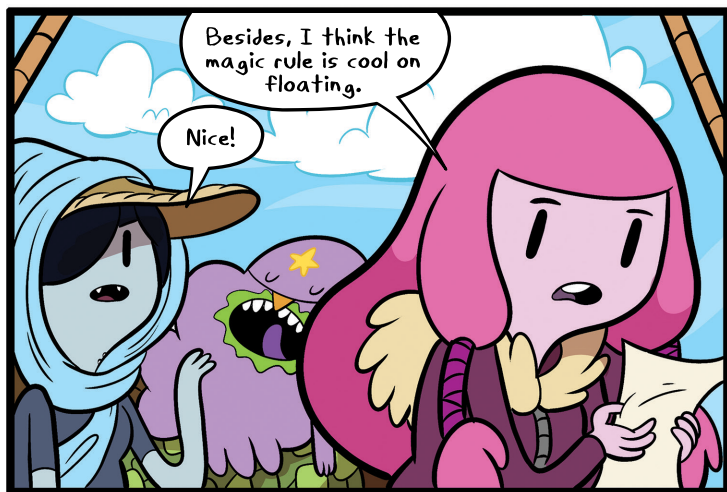
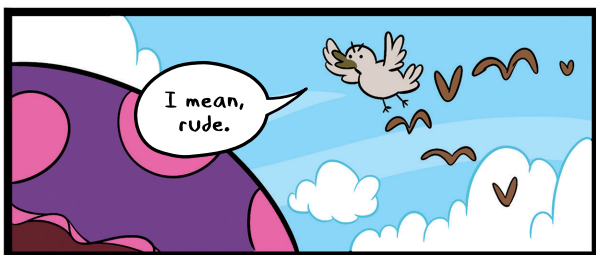
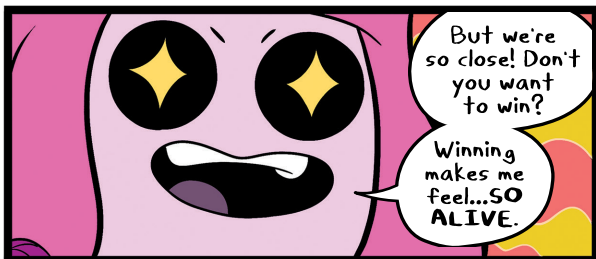
*Defenestrate (verb): To throw out of a window. In this case, it's a balloon but there's not a word for that. Deballoonestrating just sounds weird.



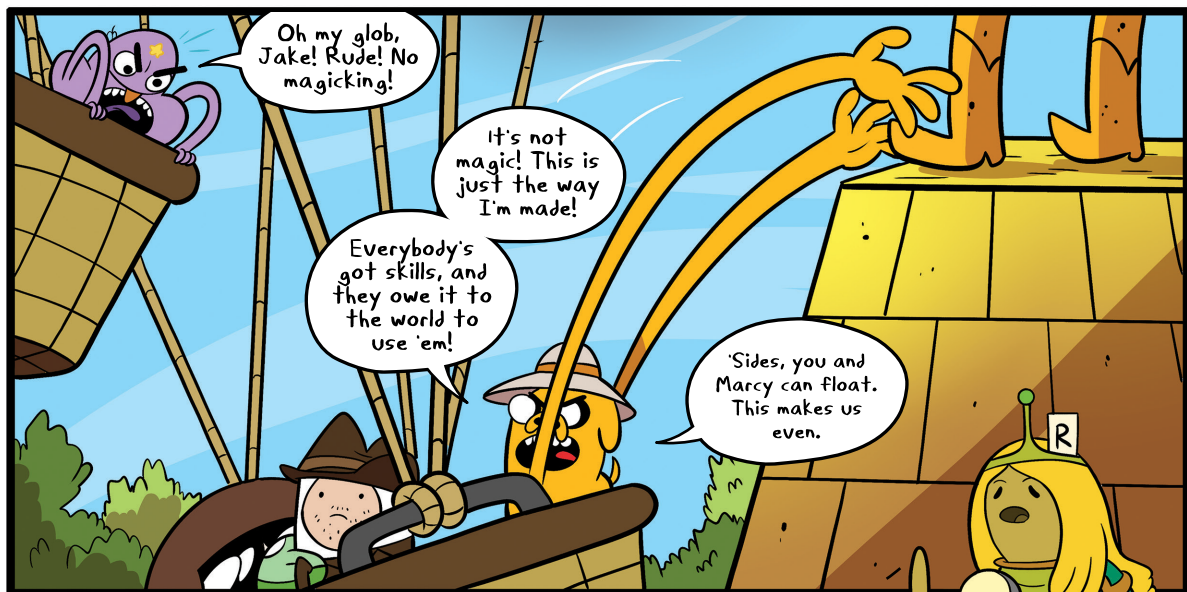

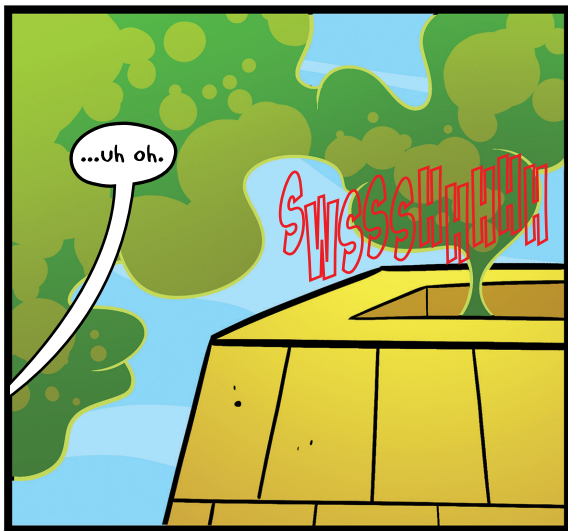
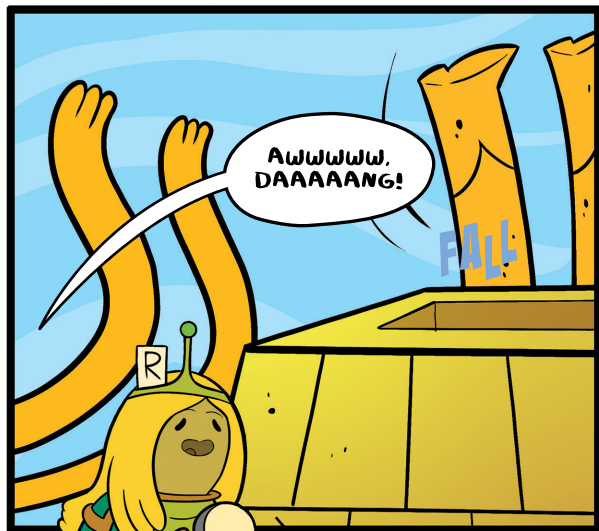
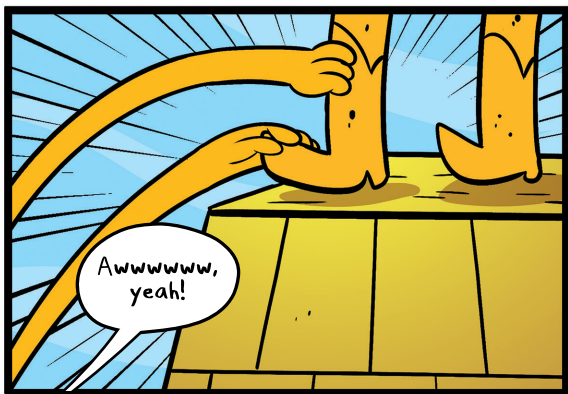
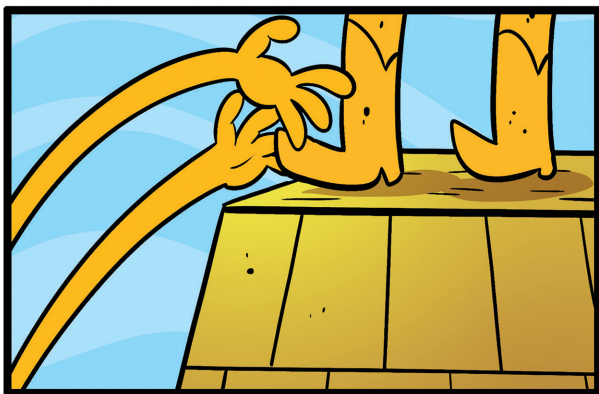
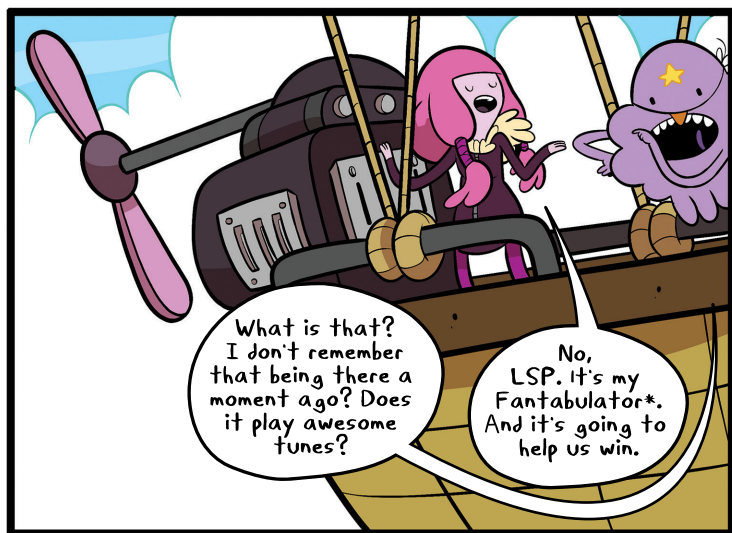
Trebuchet (noun): A kind of catapult, which is a medieval weapon that hurls stuff. Usually rocks, though. Not squirrels.



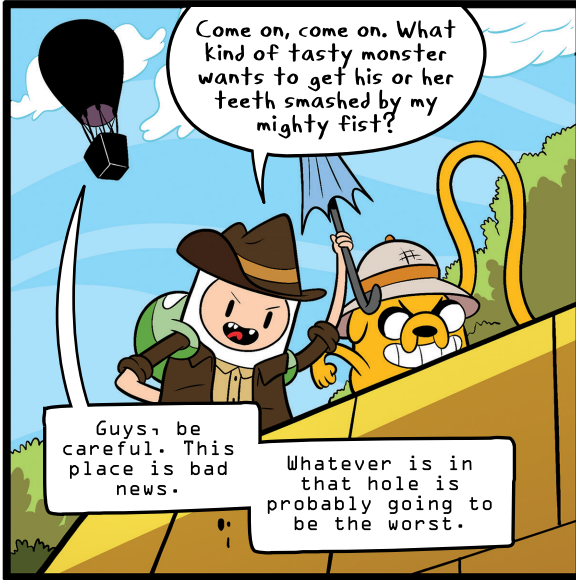
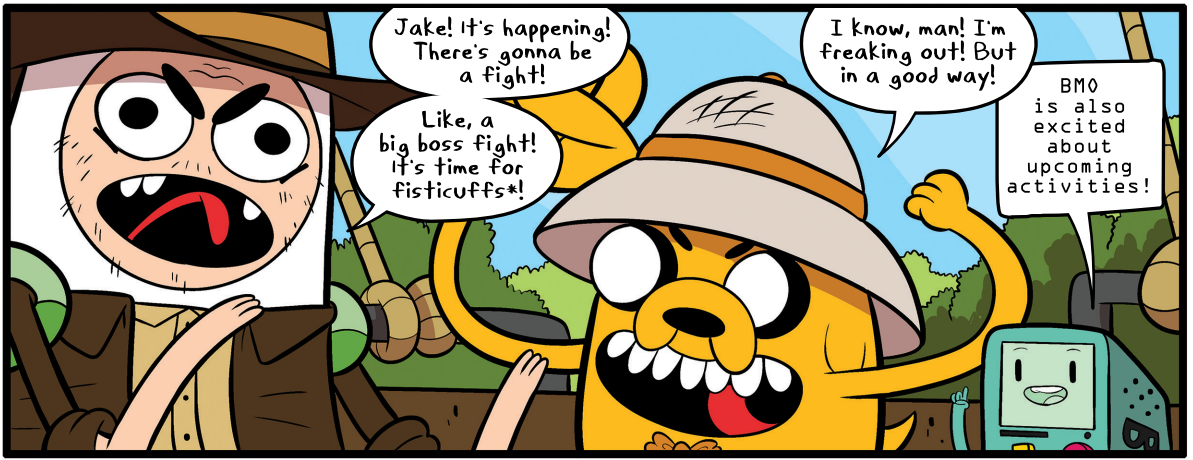
*Absquatulate (verb): To flee, to abscond, to leave abruptly.



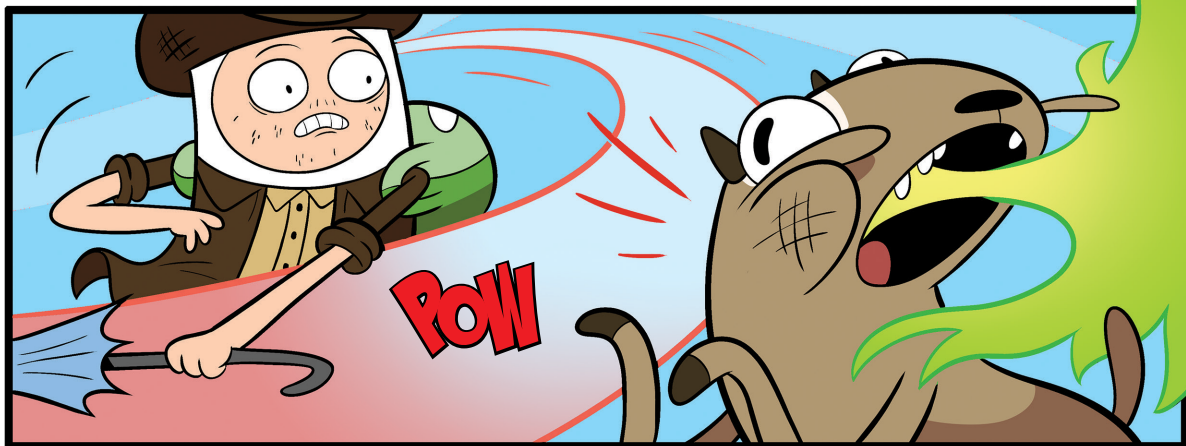
*Pedant (noun): a person who is excessively concerned with minor details and rules or with displaying academic learning.



*Fantabulator (Noun): That thing PB said. Okay, so fantabulator isn't actually a word, but it should be. Language is fluid.



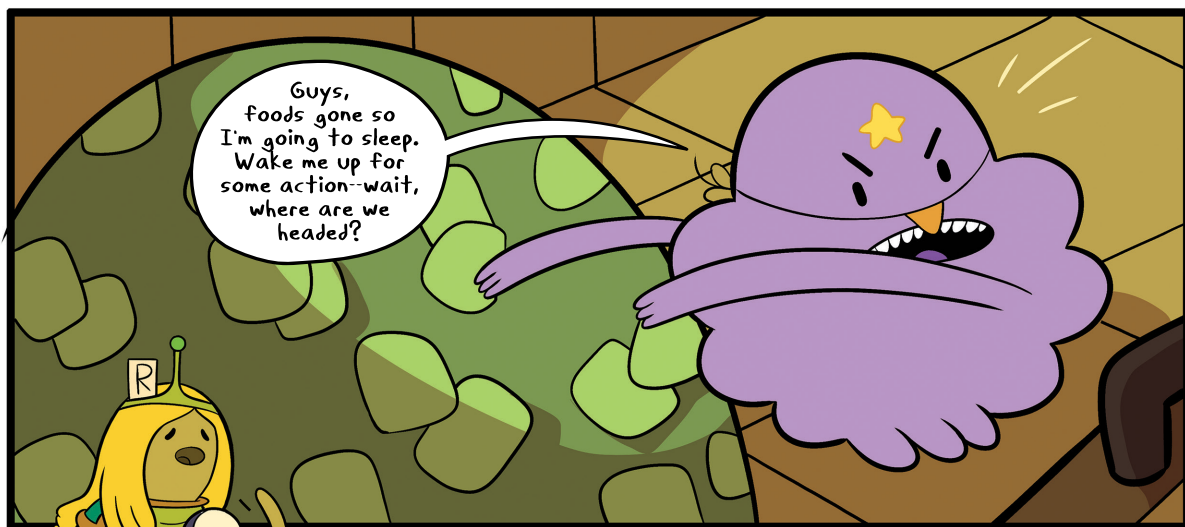
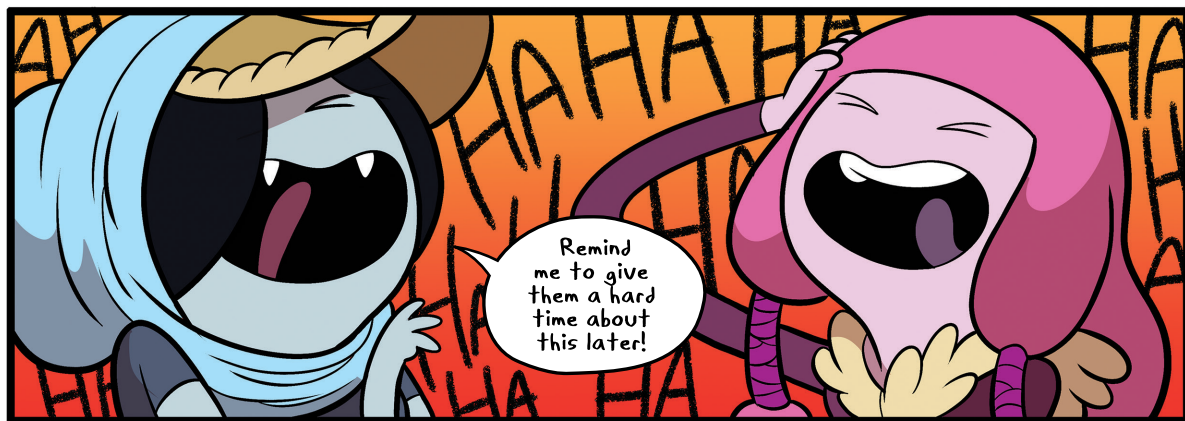
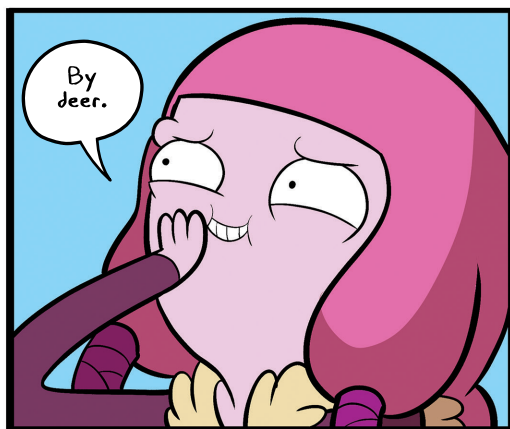
*Fisticuffs (noun): Boxing. Like, fighting with your fists. But you already knew that, right, champ?



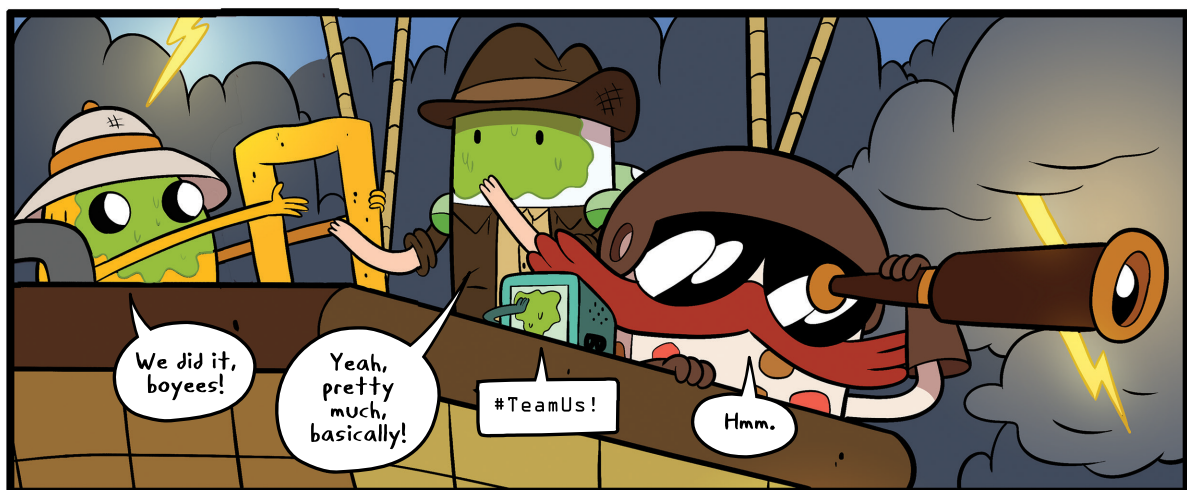
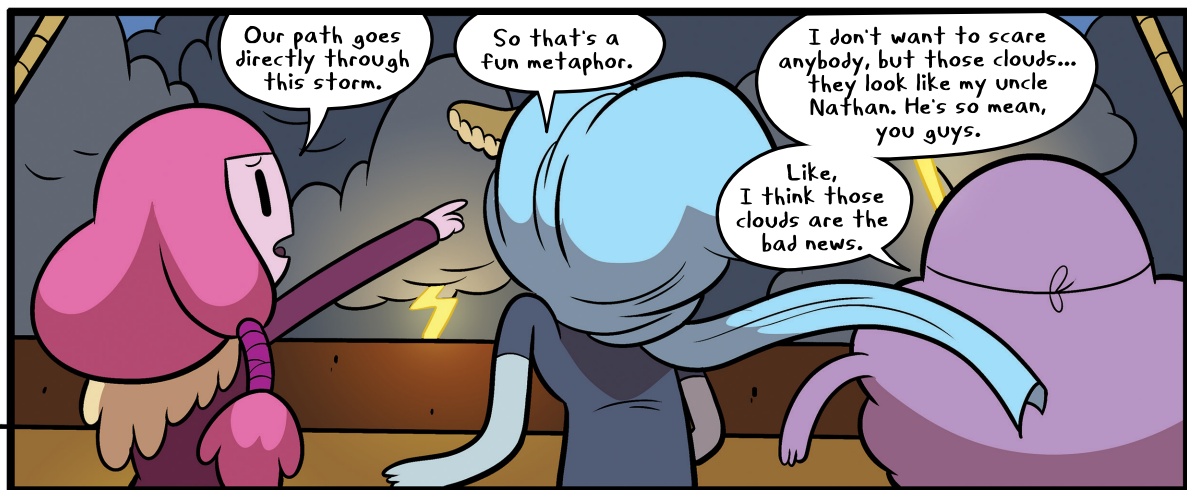
*Ziggurat (noun): An ancient Mesopotamian temple tower. Kinda like a pyramid.
